Dear parents and carers,

I hope that this letter finds you and your family well. Today, we have enjoyed a fantastic pupil-led Collective Worship by some of our Year 6 pupils. They explored issues around our world that God created and how God's vision of his creation might be different to how we are currently treating it. This included an exciting scavenger hunt by 6 pupils to retrieve items that could be swapped for more sustainable alternatives. Following this, they led a short meditation around the pupils discovering an unspoilt garden that they could retreat to in their mind if needed. They closed their worship with the hymn, 'He's Got the Whole World'. Following the responses from pupils during the Collective Worship, it is fantastic to see the impact that pupilled Collective Worship is having as part of living out our vision.



On a similar vein, next week, we will welcome our next STEM Ambassador for our monthly STEM talk. His biography can be found in our Science Spot.

In line with our *community of life-long learners*, we welcomed a PhD student from the University of Cambridge last week to conduct some research into Online Safety with our Year 5 and Year 6 pupils. We look forward to hearing the outcomes of her whole study.

Science Spot

Next Wednesday, we will enjoy our next STEM Ambassador talk. A biography of our visitor is found below.

It would be lovely to share this with your children and think of any questions they may like to ask:

I'm a neuroscientist, which means I study the brain. I am interested in the brain because it controls what we think, feel, and act. I'm really interested in hunger, which is a feeling we get that makes us act in a certain way (look for food and eat it), usually without having to think about it. Certain parts of the brain are really important for controlling hunger, and we study these in the laboratory. We can make them in a special dish and look at them under a microscope. By studying how these parts of the brain work, we are trying to find new ways to

Y5 / Y6 Craft Club


A new craft club will be set up this term for Y5 and Y6 pupils. Please see the separate invitation on the school website.
