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Our focus story this week is: *Mr Impossible and the Easter Egg Hunt* (see video on the class page)
 N.B. Some activities will be linked to this, or you might like to use it to do some activities of your own.

Phonics / Handwriting (Approx. 20-30 mins)	<p>Today, the children can revise the phoneme 'ure'. Below is a suggested structure of how you could do this.</p> <p>Warm up: Sing some songs from the <i>Phonics Menu</i> (or you can sing some of your own!)</p> <p>Then, spend a short time revising phonemes and tricky words your child knows using ideas from the <i>Phonics Revision Menu</i>.</p> <p>Phonics focus: 'ure'</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introduce the phoneme 'ure' ("<u>sure</u> it's <u>pure</u>"). Encourage the children to say the sound and 'make' or 'write' it.• Short Reading Practice<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ To practice today's phoneme, have a go playing 'Dragon's Den' on Phonics Play (you could also make a 'physical' form if you prefer). Children blend words on eggs to read them and feed them to the correct dragon: green = 'real', red = 'nonsense'. Click on the game, then select 'Phase 3' and click on the phoneme 'ure', then have fun playing!• Short Writing Practice<p>If you have time, you could then have a go playing the game 'Space Race' - Click on Phase 3 (or Phase 2 if you prefer) to practice words with a range of phonemes (including 'ure') OR You could create your own short writing challenge. Say a word from the selection below and encourage your child to make / write it. Every time they get a word correct, you could add a block to a tower, or 'win' a grape for snack time! OR Depending on your child's level, you can play 'picture matching' or 'caption writing' (see Phonics Writing Menu) to challenge your child to 'apply' their skills. <p>Reading</p> <p>(Approx. 15-20 mins)</p>	<p>Try and find a time each day to practise the sounds and words that you know in your reading record. Then read a reading book / share a story book with your parents and maybe add a comment to your reading log. You could tell us:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How you got on - was it easy / hard? What was your favourite part? OR You could draw a picture or write a comment about your book. <p>N.B. If you want some ideas for 'keeping reading alive' whilst at home, why not choose a 'reading activity' from our 'Phonics Reading Menu'.</p>
