2) Mental subtraction by rounding to the nearest 10

Read through the example, then try applying this method to the questions below. Once you have finished, check your answers with a calculator.

$$385 - 49 =$$

To make this easier to work out, we can use the method compensation.

This involves subtracting to the nearest multiple of 10 or 100 then adjusting.

So the nearest multiple of 10 is 50.

$$385 - 50 =$$

$$385 - 50 = 335$$

We then need to adjust as we needed to subtract 49 not 50. Therefore we add 1 onto our answer.

$$335 + 1 = 336$$

$$385 - 49 = 336$$
