We are continuing our work on alternate pronunciations of the graphemes we have already learnt. This week we have focused on 'ie' and 'ea'.

<p>The most common pronunciation of 'ie' is the long 'igh':</p> <p>pie lie tie</p>	<p>However in some words it makes the long 'ee' sound:</p> <p>field thief shield</p>
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<p>The most common pronunciation of 'ea' is the long 'ee':</p> <p>peach bead beach</p>	<p>However in some words it makes the short 'e' sound:</p> <p>head bread ready</p>
