*The school adopts the LA definition, which defines brother or sister as children living in the same home.

In cases of equal merit, priority will go first to children who are looked after (i.e. in public care) and then to children living nearest the school.

The COVID19 pandemic led to churches being closed for public worship under the provisions of the Coronavirus Act in March 2020. From 4 July 2020, churches were permitted to reopen for public worship in a COVID-secure way, with the decision to reopen a specific church resting locally. It is recognised that churches re-opened on different dates with different patterns of services. Further closures were also possible in certain circumstances.

This may have affected how parents have been able to show that they meet the faith-based oversubscription criterion for regular church attendance during this period of temporary church closure.

For the 2021 intake year, the school has sought an in-year variation from the Diocese which acts as a clarification as to how church attendance is to be calculated in these unique circumstances;

"In the event that during the period specified for attendance at worship the church has been closed for public worship and has not provided alternative premises for that worship, the requirements of these admissions arrangements in relation to attendance will only apply to the period when the church or alternative premises have been available for public worship".

If moving into the area during this time, we would expect contact with a local church to have been made if worship services were unavailable and attendance confirmation from the previous church leader may be sought.
