Maths Activities Menu

Number Flashcards	Make your own set 0 - 20 or find here: https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-5230-number-cards-0-20
Ordering / Sequencing	Put the flashcards in order / pick 5 at random and sequence them. Practise going forwards and backwards. Work out missing numbers or next numbers in a sequence.
Number Formation	Practise writing numbers 0 - 20. Can you make some birthday cards for friends with their age on? Look for numbers around the house.
Number Stories	Make up some number stories (addition, subtraction, doubling, halving, sharing), e.g. There are 3 oranges and 5 apples in the fruit bowl. How many pieces of fruit are there altogether?
Traditional Games	Any household board games involving counting on / back, e.g. 'Snakes and Ladders' https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-668-snakes-and-ladders-1-20
Guess My Shape	Make / find some 2D and 3D shapes. Hide in a 'feely bag' and take turns describing the shapes for others to guess.
Shape Hunt	Can you find different shapes around your home or in your garden? https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-962-shape-hunt-worksheet

Shopping	Set up your own shop! What will you sell? How much will it cost? Make some price tags and collect / make some coins to pay with.
Baking	Help your parents to measure out ingredients. You could also start making a recipe book to practise your writing skills!
Bathtime	<i>Tip: Recycle, clean and keep some plastic containers to play with in the bath.</i> How many cupfuls of water does it take to fill a bottle? Which container holds more? Can you measure the ingredients to make a potion?
Messy Maths	Loads of fun can be had outdoors collecting, investigating, counting and comparing objects. Try making a symmetrical picture or spotting shapes in the environment. Can you measure the ingredients for your mud pie? Can you make a 2D shape or even a 3D shape den using sticks?
