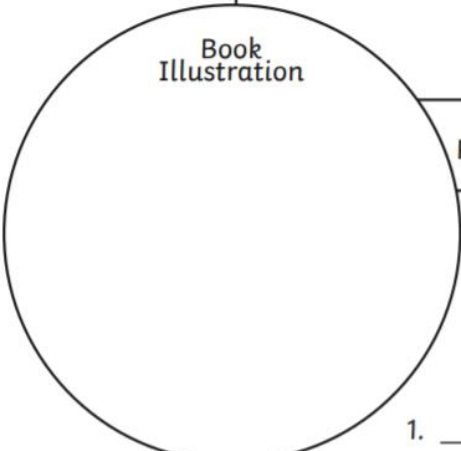

Numeracy	<u>Maths fluency lesson - times tables and subtraction</u> Please complete both of these activities to improve your maths fluency. 1) Practise your times tables for 15 minutes. You may choose from this list of activities, or find your own way to practise! - write out a table you still find tricky then ask someone to test you - use your times table booklets - TT rockstars - Find related facts for a times table fact (e.g. 3×4 is 12, so 3×40 is 120, and $1,200 \div 3 = 400$ etc.) 2) Countdown Challenge! The challenge is to use the number cards available and the four operations (+, -, $\times$ and $\div$) to hit the target, or get as close as possible.
