As I write to you, Y1 are serenading me with their nativity practice and the bells of St. Mary's have just rung as the Y6 coach departed to Grafham. It is hard to believe that we are beginning to prepare to commence Advent and prepare for our annual ways to mark and celebrate Christmas.

On the theme of preparation, we launched a new Pupil Leadership role yesterday. Dr. Goettsch, who works in conservation ecology, visited and shared themes around how we can work together to reduce our impact on the environment. Each class will have two representatives on our new Eco Committee. Pupils have been asked to consider if this is a role they are interested in. Hustings and voting will take place over the next two weeks. Dr. Goettsch, Mrs. Murray and Mrs. Scott will be working together to lead the Eco Committee through the seven steps in earning an Eco Schools green flag!

This week, I have been welcoming families to the school with a view to places for Reception 2020. It has been wonderful to share the current work of the school and to talk about the strength of the school community. I have taken great pleasure in explaining the support of the parents and governors in the recent renovation projects and other fundraising. The PTA are kindly funding some of the school's new computing hardware – 23 more iPads! You will be aware that our governors also hold the 'Shelford Support Fund'. This fund is designed to support the school's additional work and families who require additional funding in certain areas. Speaking about the immense support we have is heartening at a time when our local authority are likely to be struggling with a £16 million deficit next financial year. <u>Science Spot</u> Our biography for our next STEM Ambassador – 3/12/19

Plant Biologist

I am a plant biologist. I study how plants grow. Two years ago I started to study flowers with special petals covered by super-small bumps. When the light shines on the bumps it creates a funny colour. We study how the petals grow the little bumps. I look at the flowers with special microscopes that make the small bumps look very big and I work with a team of engineers and mathematicians to figure out how plants can build these structures. It is a bit like trying to understand what makes a bridge stand strong just by watching the bridge.
