The challenge:

The 'theme' for the photos is 'Working Scientifically' and particular merit will be given to those entries which show an application of one of the 5 types of Scientific Enquiry which we have been talking about at school (see right). There are 5 prizes up for grabs, a prize for the best selfie in EYFS, one for KSI, one for Lower KS2, one for Upper KS2 and one for staff!!

Scientific Enquiry Types

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| Comparison and Fair testing  | Changing one variable to see its effect on another, whilst keeping all others the same |
| Identifying, grouping and classifying  | Making observations to name, sort and organise items |
| Observing over time  | Observing changes that occur over a period of time ranging from minutes to months |
| Pattern seeking  | Identifying patterns and looking for relationships in enquiries where variables are difficult to control |
| Research using secondary sources  | Using secondary sources of information to answer scientific questions |
