


How to Hold a Pencil

Super Sentence Tips

• <input type="checkbox"/>	Have you started your writing in the correct place? Remember that writing goes from left to right!
C.	Have you used a capital letter at the beginning of your sentence and a full stop at the end?
M	Have you used finger spaces between words to make your writing easier to read?
Lips	Have you used your sounds to help you segment to spell words?
tw	Have you used any tricky words and are they spelled correctly?
Wow!	Have you used any describing words to add extra detail? E.g. I caught a wriggly worm.
?	Does your sentence make sense?
↔	Have you used any words to join two parts of your writing together? E.g. I caught a wriggly worm and a slimy snail. I caught a wriggly worm. Then I caught a slimy snail.
