


Literacy	<b><u>Persuasive Letter Plan - The Olympics</u></b>  Our new topic this term is 'The Olympics'. On Friday, in line with this new topic you will be writing a formal persuasive letter on one of the following (your choice): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write a persuasive letter to the International Olympics Committee (IOC) to encourage them to choose your country as the location for the next (summer) Olympic Games.</li> <li>• Write a persuasive letter to the IOC to ask them to add a new sport to the next summer Olympics (you may have to familiarise yourself with the list of current events).</li> </ul> <p>The 2020 Summer Olympics, officially the Games of the XXXII Olympiad and commonly known as Tokyo 2020, is an upcoming international multi-sport event to be held in Tokyo, Japan. Originally scheduled to take place between 24 July and 9 August 2020, the Games have been rescheduled for 23 July to 8 August 2021.</p> <p>Today's task is to plan a formal persuasive letter. Please choose an appropriate planning format that will help you with writing tomorrow's letter. <u>PLEASE DO NOT WRITE A DRAFT OF YOUR LETTER, THIS IS THE PLANNING STAGE!</u></p> <p><u>When planning think about:</u></p> <p><u>Who are you writing for (audience)</u>  <u>Why are you writing? (purpose)</u>  <u>What are you being asked to write? 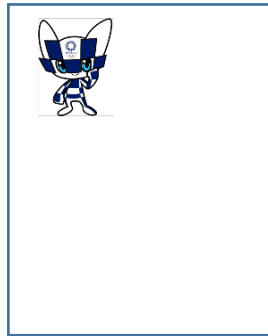
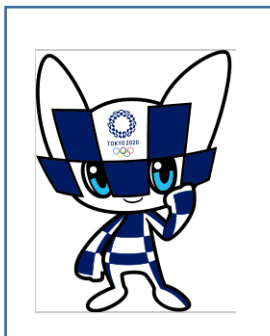

. Miraitowa is named after the Japanese words for "future" (未来, *mirai*) and "eternity" (永久, *towa*), and Someity is named after *someiyoshino*, a type of cherry blossom. Someity's name also echoes the English phrase "so mighty".
